The LEF is proud to provide support to the Lakeshore School District through our Foundation Project Grants and Innovation Grants. These grants have been awarded to staff, PTOs, parents and involved community members who have identified opportunities that enhance learning, for which only private funding can provide.

Since its inception in 1998, LEF has funded over \$140,000 in grants reaching each school building in our district, and impacting students in every grade level. LEF has also awarded students over \$14,000 through our Stepping Stones to Enrichment program.

In 2008, LEF introduced the **2¢ Campaign**, requesting 2 cents an hour from LPS staff. A \$1 or more per week gift from each individual would amass thousands of dollars- greatly impacting LEF's ability to provide for the collective enrichment of the district.
